

Japan

Women, Business and the Law 2020 presents an index covering 190 economies and structured around the life cycle of a working woman. In total, 35 questions are scored across the eight indicators. Overall scores are then calculated by taking the average of each indicator, with 100 representing the highest possible score. Data refer to the laws and regulations that are applicable to the main business city (Tokyo). Different rules may apply in other jurisdictions so local legislation should be reviewed. Based on this approach, **Japan scores 81.9 out of 100**. The overall score for Japan is lower than the regional average observed across High income (OECD) countries (94.7).

Relative Strengths

When it comes to constraints on freedom of movement, laws affecting women's work after having children, gender differences in property and inheritance, and laws affecting the size of a women's pension, Japan gets a perfect score.

Areas for Improvement

However, when it comes to laws affecting women's decisions to work, laws affecting women's pay, constraints related to marriage, and constraints on women's starting and running a business, Japan could consider reforms to improve legal equality for women.

For example, one of the lowest scores for Japan is on the indicator related to laws affecting women's decisions to work (the WBL2020 Workplace Indicator). To improve on the Workplace Indicator, Japan may wish to consider enacting legislation protecting women from sexual harassment in employment, and adopting criminal or civil penalties for sexual harassment in employment.

Recent Reforms (2018-2019)

No reforms impacting the WBL2020 indicators have been observed during the past two years.
