

# Qatar

*Women, Business and the Law 2020* presents an index covering 190 economies and structured around the life cycle of a working woman. In total, 35 questions are scored across the eight indicators. Overall scores are then calculated by taking the average of each indicator, with 100 representing the highest possible score. Data refer to the laws and regulations that are applicable to the main business city (Doha). Different rules may apply in other jurisdictions so local legislation should be reviewed. Based on this approach, **Qatar scores 32.5 out of 100**. The overall score for Qatar is lower than the regional average observed across the Middle East & North Africa (49.6).

### Relative Strengths

Qatar does not attain a perfect score on any of the WBL2020 indicators. There is room for improvement across all eight indicators.

### Areas for Improvement

However, when it comes to constraints on freedom of movement, laws affecting women's decisions to work, laws affecting women's pay, constraints related to marriage, laws affecting women's work after having children, constraints on women's starting and running a business, gender differences in property and inheritance, and laws affecting the size of a women's pension, Qatar could consider reforms to improve legal equality for women.

For example, one of the lowest scores for Qatar is on the indicator related to laws affecting women's decisions to work (the WBL2020 Workplace Indicator). To improve on the Workplace Indicator, Qatar may wish to consider allowing a woman to get a job without permission from her husband, prohibiting discrimination in employment based on gender, enacting legislation protecting women from sexual harassment in employment, and adopting criminal or civil penalties for sexual harassment in employment.

### Recent Reforms (2018-2019)

No reforms impacting the WBL2020 indicators have been observed during the past two years.
