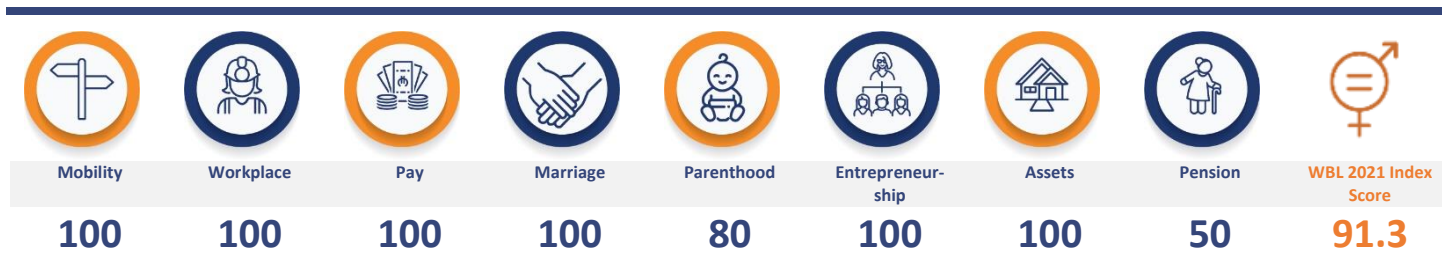


Albania

Women, Business and the Law 2021 presents an index covering 190 economies and structured around the life cycle of a working woman. In total, 35 questions are scored across the eight indicators. Overall scores are then calculated by taking the average of each indicator, with 100 representing the highest possible score. Data refer to the laws and regulations that are applicable to the main business city (Tirana). Different rules may apply in other jurisdictions so local legislation should be reviewed. Based on this approach, **Albania scores 91.3 out of 100**. The overall score for Albania is higher than the regional average observed across Europe & Central Asia (83.4). Within the Europe & Central Asia region, the maximum score observed is 93.8 (Croatia and Serbia).

Relative Strengths

When it comes to constraints on freedom of movement, laws affecting women's decisions to work, laws affecting women's pay, constraints related to marriage, constraints on women's starting and running a business, and gender differences in property and inheritance, Albania gets a perfect score.

Areas for Improvement

However, when it comes to laws affecting women's work after having children, and laws affecting the size of a woman's pension, Albania could consider reforms to improve legal equality for women.

For example, one of the lowest scores for Albania is on the indicator related to laws affecting the size of a woman's pension (the WBL2021 Pension Indicator). To improve on the Pension Indicator, Albania may wish to consider equalizing the ages at which men and women can retire with full pension benefits, and equalizing the ages at which men and women can retire with partial pension benefits.

Recent Reforms

No reforms were observed during the past year.
