

Estonia

Women, Business and the Law 2021 presents an index covering 190 economies and structured around the life cycle of a working woman. In total, 35 questions are scored across the eight indicators. Overall scores are then calculated by taking the average of each indicator, with 100 representing the highest possible score. Data refer to the laws and regulations that are applicable to the main business city (Tallinn). Different rules may apply in other jurisdictions so local legislation should be reviewed. Based on this approach, **Estonia scores 97.5 out of 100**. The overall score for Estonia is higher than the regional average observed across High income (OECD) countries (95.1). Within the High income: OECD region, there are 10 economies that score 100 out of 100.

Relative Strengths

When it comes to constraints on freedom of movement, laws affecting women's decisions to work, laws affecting women's pay, laws affecting women's work after having children, constraints on women's starting and running a business, gender differences in property and inheritance, and laws affecting the size of a woman's pension, Estonia gets a perfect score.

Areas for Improvement

However, when it comes to constraints related to marriage, Estonia could consider reforms to improve legal equality for women.

For example, one of the lowest scores for Estonia is on the indicator related to constraints related to marriage (the WBL2021 Marriage Indicator). To improve on the Marriage Indicator, Estonia may wish to consider enacting legislation protecting women from domestic violence.

Recent Reforms

No reforms were observed during the past year.
