

Greece

Women, Business and the Law 2022 (WBL2022) presents an index covering 190 economies and structured around the life cycle of a working woman. In total, 35 questions are scored across eight indicators. Overall scores are then calculated by taking the average of each indicator, with 100 representing the highest possible score. Data refer to the laws and regulations that are applicable to the main business city (Athens). Different rules may apply in other jurisdictions so local legislation should be reviewed. Based on this approach, **Greece scores 100 out of 100**. The overall score for Greece is higher than the regional average observed across OECD high-income economies (95.2). Within the OECD high-income region, there are 12 economies that score 100 out of 100.

Relative Strengths

When it comes to constraints on freedom of movement, laws affecting women's decisions to work, laws affecting women's pay, constraints related to marriage, laws affecting women's work after having children, constraints on women starting and running a business, gender differences in property and inheritance, and laws affecting the size of a woman's pension, Greece gets a perfect score.

Areas for Improvement

Greece attains a perfect score on all of the WBL2022 indicators.

Recent Reforms

During the past year (October 2nd, 2020 – October 1st, 2021), Greece introduced 2 months of paid parental leave as an individual entitlement for each parent.
